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THREE SAINTS SOUTH ELMHAM LITTER PICK REPORT - 27 -28 April 2019

Results

The litter pick took place as planned in All Saints on 27 and 28 April 2019. About 10 volunteers collected about 8 bags and other assorted rubbish. In addition, 2 other volunteers did ragwort pulling along the road between the end of the Common and Rumburgh.

No volunteers came from St Peters or St Michaels so those areas were not covered.

The Council failed to collect the rubbish on time so John Flatt kindly removed it himself (I informed the Council so they could cancel the collection).

Method

I am making this note of the method in case it useful for future reference. Now we know the system it will be much easier next time.

The procedure to use the Council equipment was followed- requires form filling and some phone calls. I have kept the details on file. Equipment is delivered and collected (rather more efficiently than the filled rubbish bags) albeit not to the address requested. After the pick I sent in the photos required for grant and the draw.

Equipment was signed out on the day and arrangements for return made for items not handed back on Sunday.

Publicity was through our Notice Boards, delivery of leaflets in All Saints, Facebook, Sange's Newsletter, the Rumburgh Village Hall notice Board, Coffee morning and Word of Mouth.

Recommendations

- 1 Timing: Most people said earlier in the year would be better as rubbish would be more visible. We did want to do it earlier but we waited for the Council notice. I think in future we could choose an earlier date. After all it couldn't have been any colder?
- 2 DIY approach? We should get a £20 grant for picking our litter- perhaps this could go towards our own kit? The hoops and sticks each cost about £20. Given we needed 10 kits for All Saints I think we would still need to borrow from the Council for an organised picking event. We could consider if Rumburgh wanted buy and share equipment?
- 3 We need to improve the Council's efficiency in collecting the resulting rubbish. Now I know who to phone and email I can chase immediately. We need to avoid Bank Holidays as it is gives the potential for long delays in getting hold of the Council and collection of rubbish.
