

TOP TEN REPORT FOR BUNGAY AND THE VILLAGES (JULY 26)

Endeavour House

Suffolk is currently scheduled to move from its existing two-tier local government structure (county, district and borough councils) to three new unitary councils, with implementation planned for April 2028 and elections for the new authorities expected in May 2027.

Suffolk County Council has decided to proceed with a legal challenge against the government's decision regarding the proposed reorganisation.

In addition I have attended Scrutiny training in person and numerous other training sessions via Teams. I have also been appointed to several outside bodies including Suffolk & Essex Coast and Heaths National Landscapes Joint Advisory Committee.

Bungay

I have had meetings with the Traffic working party, Highways and our local Police officers regarding anti-social behaviour in and around our town.
